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
Exhibition Floor Plan 14 - 17 September 2024

If so, you can reach our attendees by listing your fringe in our Conference Directory and on the Conference App for £450 +VAT. All venues must be fully wheelchair accessible and comply with the fringe programme times. Please contact us prior to securing a venue.

Fringes - exclusive advertising discounts

There are many ways to enhance your presence at conference and showcase your organisation. Opportunities and discounts outlined below are only available at the time of booking your fringe. You will find them listed within the 'Fringe Event Agreement' when booking your fringe event. All advertising rates can be found by downloading the Advertising Booking Form on page 9.

A quick summary of advertising discounts are below:

- Highlight your fringe on the conference app and within the directory for £175 and/or extend your listing from 40 to 60 words for £175
- Advertise on the conference app for £1,100 and/or request a push notification via the app in real time. Remind delegates of your fringe 30 minutes beforehand for £200 (60% saving)
- Insert a full-page advert within the conference directory for £1,960 (30% saving) or half-page £1,380 (22% saving)
- Pin a tweet 2 days before and for the duration of conference achieving 1000's of hits for £850 (15% saving) or book a unpinned daily tweet each day for £175
- Send a personalised fringe email to all attendees for £1,500 (11.5% saving) or book a group email shot with a small number of other organisations for £450 (18% saving)
- Insert a flyer in the Conference Directory (A5) for £1,400 or distribute your magazine, booklet, A4 /A5 flyer at on-site literature distribution points. Prices start from £765 (10% saving)


