#### Legal Maximum -**Local elections**

£960 plus 8p

Reduced by a quarter (25%)

if two candidates

4000 electors=


Reduced by a third (33%) if three candidates

 $(4000 \times 0.08) + 960 = £1,280$ 

Wales & Scotland remain £806 plus 7p per elector
